Many women released from an incarcerating facility are given the same t-shirt and sweats. Unfortunately, this screams, "I just got out" and I feel shame and marginalized. It is so degrading.

Our Date at the Gate will help you feel better and confident. We provide each woman requesting these services with clothing, shoes, under garments, and a bag for their release. Each woman can request up to two outfits, one casual and one professional.
